If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father, because the Father is greater than I. ²⁹ And now I have told you this before it occurs, so that when it does occur you may believe.

It is hard for most of us to comprehend what they are facing this day.

By your Holy Spirit, pour out your love and compassion. Bring peace to our world and comfort to those who mourn.

Be with our leaders. Guide the decisions they make, so that the poor and the weak are protected. And that our resources are used well to help those who are in need.

Be in all that your church is doing in this world and in our region. Help us to be your presence in our communities, moving quietly through and around the lives of people, supporting, encouraging and loving them, working as agents of change.

By your Holy Spirit, show us how to love as you love. May we be your hands and your voice for those who so often go unnoticed.

Continue, Lord, to watch over those who are unwell or struggling with the situations they find themselves in. God of compassion, meet people in the darkness and pain of their lives. Show them that they loved unconditionally by you.

Please take a moment to lift before God those who are on your hearts.

Holy Communion

Jesus invites us to this table.

The meal is open to all who hunger.

It is a place for peace making, and nourishment by God's love.

Through these elements, and by the power of the Holy Spirit, we remember that Jesus was present with his disciples, that he is present with us today and that he will be with us for all eternity with his Father.

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

And also with you.

Be present, risen Lord Jesus, as you were with your disciples,

And make yourself known to us in the breaking of the bread; For you live and reign with the Father, and the Holy Spirit, One God, for ever and ever **Amen.**

According to our saviour's command, we set this bread and this cup apart for the holy supper to which he calls us.

The Lord be with you.
Lift up your hearts.
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

And also with you.

We lift them to the Lord

It is right to give our thanks and praise

Thanks, and praise, glory and honour are rightly yours, our Lord and God, for you alone are worthy. In time beyond our dreaming, you brought forth life from darkness, and in the love of Christ, your son, you set humanity to join you in caring for your creation.

You have called us to be your church in this place, to give voice to every creature under heaven. We rejoice with all you have made, as we join with all the company of heaven in their eternal song:

Blessing and honour and glory are yours, forever and ever, Amen.

Loving God, accept us, as we offer and present ourselves, our souls and bodies, to be a holy and living sacrifice, through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with you and the Holy Spirit, be all honour and glory, now and for ever. **Amen**

And so, we join together in prayer as believers have been doing for centuries:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread.

Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and for ever.

Amen.

On the night when he was betrayed, Jesus shared a meal with his friends.
